- Are you a PARENT?** Parents are the primary evangelists for their children. Serving as a catechist for your child's class or another class supports all parents' responsibilities for handing on the faith.
- Are you a GRANDPARENT?** Stay connected with the vitality of youth.
- Are you BILINGUAL?** We have a special need for catechists who accommodate children of Spanish-speaking parents.

WHAT YOU NEED TO COMMIT

Catechists need to be regular participants at parish liturgies and have completed the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist). The children in our program deserve the commitment of adults who will make it a priority to create loving and respectful environments in the classroom. A catechist must commit to the scheduled classes/events for his or her grade level. The calendar generally follows the Public Schools calendar. We will train, support, guide, and pray with you. Volunteers who work with children & youth are required to sign a Volunteer Code of Conduct, complete the Criminal Record Check process and attend a **Protecting God's Children** Training Session.

IF YOU ARE NOT READY TO TAKE THIS STEP ALONE...CONSIDER "TEAM-TEACHING"

A team may consist of two catechists or one catechist and assistant. A co-catechist/assistant can be a parent, friend, or a junior/senior high school student. An assistant may help with group work, teach various segments of the lesson, maintain discipline, work one-on-one with a particular student, or substitute the class in a pinch.
