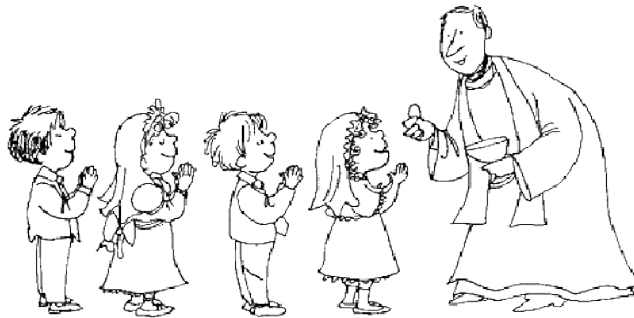

Registration for First Sacraments

Preparing for the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist is a two-year process beginning in Grade 1 for children attending private or public school.

Children attending Catholic School receive instruction from the school but prepare to receive the first sacraments through St. Joseph Parish Religious Education Program.

Children attending public or private school should enroll their child in St. Joseph Parish Religious Education Program and he or she receives instruction at religious education classes at the parish.

If you wish to enroll your child in St. Joseph Religious Education Program and prepare her or him to receive the sacraments, please complete the enclosed forms and return them by mail with a copy of your child's Baptismal certificate.

Level 1 is home taught by the parent and the child attends monthly Activity Sessions at the school. Level 1 sessions are held on Mondays at 4:45-5:45PM or 6:45-7:45PM.

Level 2 children attend weekly classes at the school on Tuesday or Wednesday and prepare to receive the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist during year 2.
